Day 1 : Top Vizag Tours Start at the Shore: From Bheemili to RK Beach

☐ Arrive at Vizag and begin your journey with a warm welcome. You'll be transferred to your hotel, followed by check-in as per standard policy. Once refreshed, head out to explore Vizag's rich coastline — blending history, viewpoints, and secret coastal charms.

Destination	Highlights
Bheemili Beach (4.4☐) Open All Day	Begin your day at this peaceful heritage beach town — home to colonial ruins, an old lighthouse, and the serene Gosthani River meeting the sea.
<i>Scenic drive toward Thotlakonda (via Ramanaidu) — this stretch hides secluded coves, secret cliff trails, and empty beach pockets locals rarely mention. Great for photo stops and quiet moments. (approx. 30 mins)</i>	
Ramanaidu Viewpoint (4.5☐) 9:00 AM – 6:00 PM Open Daily	A cinematic hilltop location offering aerial sea views and open-air tranquillity. Ideal for panoramic photos and a brief refreshment stop.
Thotlakonda Monastery (4.3☐) 9:00 AM – 5:00 PM Open All Days	This ancient Buddhist complex rests atop a breezy cliff. The ruins and meditation platforms here face the ocean, offering silence and scenic charm.
<i>Proceed to Rushikonda Beach (approx. 15 mins)</i>	
Rushikonda Beach (4.5☐) 6:00 AM – 6:00 PM Open Daily	Vizag's most vibrant beach. Known for water sports, beachfront stalls, and lively energy. Ideal for a refreshing dip or snack break.
<i>Continue to Sagar Nagar Beach (approx. 5 mins)</i>

Day 2 : Sacred Hills & Seaside Trails - From Simhachalam to Hidden Coastal Corners

☐ Your second day weaves together spiritual elevation, secluded beaches, and military-protected panoramas. From the sacred slopes of Simhachalam to the raw beauty of Yarada Beach and the cliff-edge views of Dolphin Hill, this route blends calm devotion with awe-inspiring coastal visuals. Expect fewer crowds, uninterrupted vistas, and access to one of the most photo-worthy circuits of coastal Vizag.

Destination	Highlights
Simhachalam Temple (4.6☐) Timings: 7:00 AM – 3:30 PM & 6:00 PM – 9:00 PM Open All Days	Hilltop Narasimha temple famed for its carvings and spiritual ambiance. Early visits offer a peaceful experience with minimal queues.
Scenic Drive via NAD & Naval Roads (~40 mins)	Quiet, green routes with elevated glimpses of the Bay of Bengal, leading toward Vizag's naval belt.

Destination	Highlights
Yarada Beach (4.5) Timings: 6:00 AM - 6:30 PM Open All Days	Hidden crescent beach surrounded by green hills. No crowds, no shops—just golden sand and solitude.
Dolphin Hill Viewpoint (4.3) Timings: 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM Closed: Mondays	Cliffside naval zone with expansive views of Vizag Port and the open ocean. Entry allowed with original ID. Return back to the hotel
Vizag Lighthouse (4.1) Timings: 10:00 AM - 5:00 PM Closed: Sundays

Day 3 : From Caves to Cloudline - Araku Adventures

□ This leg of your journey takes you from the coastal city of Vizag into the elevated valleys of Araku — a region known for its natural caves, tribal coffee estates, and panoramic viewpoints.

Today begins with the iconic Vizag-Araku train ride through a series of tunnels, bridges, and forested hills. If rail seats aren't secured, a scenic road transfer via Ananthagiri will ensure you don't miss the views. Your day flows through ancient cave systems, jungle treks to waterfalls, and ends amidst coffee plantations in a quiet Araku resort.

Destination	Highlights
Vizag-Araku Train Ride (4.7) Departure ~6:50 AM	Enjoy one of India's most scenic railway routes, featuring 50+ tunnels, hill curves, and panoramic Eastern Ghat views. Tip: Book tickets at least a week in advance. First-class seats recommended for comfort and views.
<i>Alternate: If train unavailable, proceed by road via Ananthagiri with flexible sightseeing stops en route.</i>	
Borra Caves (4.5) 10:00 AM - 5:00 PM	A spectacular cave system over a million years old. Naturally formed stalactites and spiritual legends make this a memorable stop. Note: Carry a torch if you want to explore dim corners; walk cautiously on wet patches.
Katiki Waterfalls (4.4) Open till 5:30 PM <i>Private Jeep + 1 km Forest Trek</i>	Reach this jungle-hidden waterfall by a rugged jeep ride and a trek. A raw, photogenic setting perfect for nature lovers. Tip: Local jeeps can be hired at the base for approx ₹1200. Don't forget a water bottle and trekking shoes.
Coffee Plantations (4.6) Anytime Access	Explore rolling estates where tribal communities grow, process, and brew rich coffee blends unique to Araku. Special Tip: Look for tribal-run stalls to enjoy a cup of strong filter coffee.
Galikonda View Point (4.4) Best Before Sunset	Take in sweeping views of the Araku Valley from one of the highest drivable peaks in Andhra Pradesh. A calm and windy spot. Note: Avoid visiting after dark as the curves can get foggy.

Evening Comfort: Check in at your Araku hotel/resort. Rest well. Enjoy the climate.

Day 4 : Hidden Highlands: The Scenic Route Few Take from araku to vizag

□ Hidden Highlands: The Scenic Route Few Take

Skip the usual highway and take the road that winds through whispering pines, forest waterfalls, and tribal hamlets. This detour from Araku to Vizag is a visual treat — calm, quiet, and packed with natural charm.

Destination	Highlights
Araku Pine Grove (4.4□)	Fresh morning air, pine-scented trails, and soft light filtering through tall trees. A peaceful start to the return journey. No trek needed - just park and soak in the vibes.
Chaparai Streams (4.5□)	Known for its picture-perfect flow over flat rocks, this is a great spot for quick clicks and cool dips. Walk-in access ; just watch your step on wet rocks.
Theegalavalasa Waterfall (4.2□)	A quiet little fall hidden just a short stroll off the main road. Nature at its unfiltered best. ~10 min forest walk through light trails.
Palagarevu Waterfalls (4.3□)	Tucked away in a forest patch, this small waterfall offers calm and shade — a perfect mid-way refresh. Walk required : ~10-12 mins on an easy path.
Dallapalli Scenic Stretch	Few know of this lush countryside drive. Think misty hills, valley viewpoints, and rural charm at every turn. Zero trekking - just roll your windows down and enjoy.
Forest Descent via Paderu-Anakapalle	This route flows through green ridges, tribal roads, and winding passes — perfect for ending your trip on a scenic note. Tip : Carry snacks — there aren't many shops en route.
Back to Vizag	Reach Vizag by evening after a day full of relaxed exploration. Flexible drop-off : Hotel, station, or airport as needed.
