Day 1 : Your Vizag Araku Package Begins with a Stunning Beach Day

□ Your journey begins with a warm welcome at Vizag. Our representative will escort you to your hotel, followed by check-in as per standard policy. Soon after, you'll embark on a hand-curated coastal route that not only includes the city's top spots, but also reveals the lesser-seen charms that lie in between.

This isn't just a sightseeing day — it's an immersive journey through Vizag's coastal soul, uncovering quiet cliffs, secluded bays, and sea-kissed heritage points between Bheemili and RK Beach.

Destination	Description
Bheemili Beach (4.4□) Open All Day	Begin your day where the Gosthani River meets the sea. This beach town blends Dutch heritage, fishing villages, and tranquil shorelines.
<i>Scenic drive to Thotlakonda via Ramanaidu - This stretch is filled with hidden gems: cliff-side bends, sandy curves, and quiet spots where you'll feel like the only one there. Stop where your heart says pause. (approx. 30 mins)</i>	
Ramanaidu Viewpoint (4.5□) 9:00 AM - 6:00 PM Open Daily	A peaceful hilltop above the sea — located within a film studio. Offers cinematic views and breezy silence ideal for photo breaks.
Thotlakonda Monastery (4.3□) 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM Open All Days	An ancient Buddhist site atop a breezy plateau, overlooking the Bay of Bengal. A reflective, open-space walk through history and calm.
<i>Drive to Rushikonda Beach (approx. 15 mins)</i>	
Rushikonda Beach (4.5□) 6:00 AM - 6:00 PM Open Daily	Well-known for its energy, this beach is perfect for water sports, local snacks, and people-watching. Optional: try a jet ski ride or sip coconut water by the waves.
<i>Short ride to Sagar Nagar Beach (approx. 5 mins)</i>	
Sagar Nagar Beach (4.3□) Open All Day	Quiet and uncrowded, this beach is ideal for photos, drone shots, or simply taking in the vast blue in peace.
<i>Scenic climb to Kailasagiri Park (approx. 20 mins)</i>	
Kailasagiri (4.4□) 10:00 AM - 6:00 PM Open Daily	One of Vizag's most iconic stops — features a hilltop ropeway, Shiva-Parvati statues, manicured lawns, and unbeatable sea views.
<i>Descend to Tenneti Park (approx. 10 mins)</i>	
Tenneti Park (4.4□) 6:00 AM - 9:00 PM Open Daily	Open-air cliffside park with sitting zones, sea mist, and quiet pathways. A quick pause here sets the mood before you wrap up the day.
<i>Final leg to RK Beach (approx. 10 mins)</i>	
RK Beach & Museums (4.6□) 2:00 PM - 8:30 PM Museums Closed: Mondays	End your day where Vizag comes alive — with a walk by the sea, visits to the Submarine Museum and TU 142 Aircraft Museum, and maybe a quick bite nearby.

Day 2 : Spiritual Heights & Seaside Serenity – Annavaram to Vizag City Tour

□ A divine coastal circuit that begins with sunrise prayers and winds through Vizag’s scenic shorelines, iconic viewpoints, and sacred landmarks.

Start early and head north to the revered Annavaram Temple. After offering prayers, the journey returns along the coastline—exploring Yarada’s golden beach, panoramic sea cliffs, and finishing with a mix of temples and urban greens before hotel drop.

Destination	Highlights
Annavaram Temple (4.7□) Timings: 6:00 AM - 1:00 PM & 3:00 PM - 8:30 PM Closed: Open All Days	Famous hilltop temple of Sri Satyanarayana Swamy, overlooking the Pampa River. Known for its rituals and scenic setting. Tips: Climb via steps or use hill drive. Ideal time: early morning for darshan and cool climate.
<i>Return drive to Vizag (~120 km / 3 hrs). Suggested breakfast stop on the highway route.</i>	
Yarada Beach (4.5□) Timings: 6:00 AM - 6:30 PM Closed: Open All Days	Quiet, horseshoe-shaped beach flanked by lush hills. Ideal for photos, short walks, and light refreshment. Tips: Carry drinking water; no nearby cafes. Visit before 12 PM for soft lighting.
Vizag Lighthouse (4.1□) Timings: 3:00 PM - 5:00 PM Closed: Mondays	Short spiral climb with wide panoramic views over Yarada and the Bay of Bengal. Tips: Reach on time—entry closes sharp at 5 PM. Wear footwear with grip. Entry fee ~₹10.
Dolphin Nose Viewpoint (4.3□) Timings: 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM Closed: Mondays	Naval-controlled hilltop offering sweeping views of the port and coastline. Tips: Entry may require ID. Access can be restricted—confirm on day of travel.
Simhachalam Temple (4.6□) Timings: 7:00 AM - 3:30 PM & 6:00 PM - 9:00 PM Closed: Open All Days	A sacred Narasimha Swamy temple on a forested hill. Known for peaceful ambiance and intricate sculpture. Tips: Avoid post-noon crowd; carry change for offerings and lockers.
VUDA Central Park (4.3□) Timings: 9:00 AM - 8:00 PM Closed: Tuesdays Optional Stop (Time Permitting)	A landscaped urban garden ideal for relaxing walks, kids’ play zones, and musical fountains. Tips: Golf carts available for seniors (~₹25). Ideal for cooling off after temple visits.
<i>Final drop to hotel in Vizag. Optional dinner stop can be arranged en route.</i>	

Note: Day 2 includes ~220 km of travel (including Annavaram round trip) and 12 hours of vehicle usage. Early start strongly recommended to cover all locations comfortably.

Day 3 : Vizag- Srikakulam Temples

□ Embark on a spiritually enriching temple trail that spans centuries of devotion and architecture. This circuit through north Andhra's sacred spots includes rare temples dedicated to the Sun, Vishnu in his Kurma avatar, and Lord Shiva, all set in picturesque and historically rich locations. The journey wraps with a scenic hill temple stop before returning to Vizag.

Temple / Location (Timings)	Description
Arasavilli Sun Temple 6:00 AM - 12:30 PM, 4:00 PM - 8:00 PM	One of the oldest Sun temples in India, dedicated to Lord Suryanarayana. Unique architectural layout allowing sun rays to fall on the deity's feet twice a year.
Srikurmam Temple 6:00 AM - 11:30 AM, 4:00 PM - 8:00 PM	Ancient temple dedicated to Lord Vishnu in Kurma (tortoise) avatar — the only one of its kind in the world. Located near the coast.
Srimukhalingam Temple 6:00 AM - 12:00 PM, 4:00 PM - 7:30 PM	Architecturally significant temple dedicated to Lord Shiva on the banks of River Vamsadhara. Known for Kalinga-style carvings and peaceful riverside setting.
Ramatheertham 6:00 AM - 11:30 AM, 4:00 PM - 7:30 PM	Scenic hill temple dedicated to Lord Rama, located en route while returning to Vizag. Offers views, ancient caves, and spiritual serenity.

Day 4 : Eastern Ghats Escape - Vizag to Araku by Rail, Caves & Coffee Experience

□ Leave the coastline behind as you climb into the heart of the Eastern Ghats — where scenic rail routes meet tribal traditions and misty highland charm.

The morning begins with a memorable transfer from Vizag to Araku — ideally by train for the full scenic route, or by road if rail tickets are unavailable. You'll spend the day exploring Araku's natural and cultural gems, including limestone caves, forest waterfalls, and coffee plantations, before settling into your hillside resort for a restful evening.

Destination	Highlights
Vizag-Araku Rail Journey (4.7□) Departure ~6:50 AM	This railway route is famous for its 58 tunnels, lush valleys, and panoramic views as it cuts through the Eastern Ghats. Tip: Choose window seats. Carry water and light snacks for the 4-hour ride.
<i>□ Alternate Option: A scenic road transfer via Ananthagiri Ghat with opportunities for photo stops and nature breaks.</i>	
Borra Caves (4.5□) 10:00 AM - 5:00 PM	These ancient caves are filled with stalactites, hidden shrines, and natural rock art shaped over centuries. Note: Some areas are dim and slippery — use caution and wear suitable shoes.
Katiki Waterfalls (4.4□) Open till 5:30 PM 1 km Forest Trek + Local Jeep	Set off on a short trek after an exciting jeep ride to reach this picturesque jungle waterfall. Tip: Visit during post-monsoon months for full flow. Keep camera gear protected from splashes.

Destination	Highlights
Tribal Coffee Plantations (4.6) Accessible All Day	Visit the plantations that power Araku’s rich coffee culture. Meet local growers, sample brews, and learn about bean processing. Special Tip: Pepper coffee is a regional specialty worth trying.
Galikonda View Point (4.4) Recommended before Sunset	At over 4,000 ft, this is one of the highest motorable points in Andhra Pradesh, offering valley views and refreshing wind. Note: Carry a scarf or jacket — it's noticeably cooler at this elevation.

Evening in Araku: Check in to your resort. Take in the quiet town ambiance of the hill station and prepare for the next chapter of your journey.

□ Araku to Vizag: Offbeat Return with Nature Highlights

This return route is designed for travelers who prefer nature, silence, and local charm over traffic and crowds. Experience waterfalls, hill drives, and scenic villages on your way back to Vizag.

Destination	Highlights
Araku Pinery (4.4)	Short roadside stop amid pine trees. Good for stretching and photos. Access: Vehicle-friendly; no trekking required.
Chaparai Rock Stream (4.5)	Gentle cascade over flat stone surfaces. A popular photo point. Access: Close to parking; minimal walking involved.
Theegalavalasa Falls (4.2)	A quiet forest waterfall reached by a short walk (~10-15 mins). Tip: Ideal stop post-monsoon for water flow and greenery.
Palagarevu Waterfalls (4.3)	Less crowded fall with a mild forest trail (~10-12 mins). Note: Carry footwear with grip; no facilities nearby.
Dallapalli Region	Drive through hilly tribal belts with scenic roadside views. Optional stop: Viewpoints available; no trek needed.
Paderu to Anakapalle	Descent through forested terrain and valleys, ending near Vizag city limits. Note: Longer route but significantly more scenic.
Vizag Drop	Evening arrival in Vizag. Final drop-off at hotel, airport, or station as per your plan.
