## Tour Itinerary

### Day 1 : Scenic Start to Your Vizag Trip - Coastal Explorer

□ Welcome to Vizag! On arrival, our representative will greet you and assist with transfer to your hotel. After check-in (as per hotel policy), begin your journey along one of India's most scenic coastal highways

— filled with beaches, viewpoints, ancient sites, and secret escapes.

Destination	Highlights
<b>Bheemili Beach (4.4 )</b> <b>Open All Day</b>	A peaceful coastal town with Dutch-era structures, ancient churches, and a scenic river meeting the Bay of Bengal. Great place to ease into your trip.
<i>Continue along the Vizag-Bheemili beach road — enjoy secluded viewpoints, rocky inlets, and untouched sands nestled between the cliffs. These lesser-known spots are ideal for drone shots, picnic halts, or simply peace and quiet. (approx. 30 mins)</i>	
<b>Ramanaidu Hill Viewpoint (4.5 )</b> <b>9:00 AM – 6:00 PM</b> <b>Open Daily</b>	Perched above the coast inside a film studio complex, this spot offers one of the finest panoramic views of the sea and surroundings.
<b>Thotlakonda Monastery (4.3 )</b> <b>9:00 AM – 5:00 PM</b> <b>Open Daily</b>	An excavated Buddhist site sitting atop a hill. Great for culture lovers and panoramic sea photography, with ocean winds all around.
<i>Short scenic drive to Rushikonda Beach (approx. 15 mins)</i>	
<b>Rushikonda Beach (4.5 )</b> <b>6:00 AM – 6:00 PM</b> <b>Open Daily</b>	One of Vizag’s most energetic beaches. Adventure sports, beach cafés, and lots of people-watching make this a vibrant stop.
<i>Continue to Sagar Nagar Beach (approx. 5 mins)</i>	
<b>Sagar Nagar Beach (4.3 )</b> <b>Open All Day</b>	A calm and clean beach stretch — less commercial, more local. Perfect for relaxed beach walks and coastal photography.
<i>Drive uphill to Kailasagiri Park (approx. 20 mins)</i>	
<b>Kailasagiri (4.4 )</b> <b>10:00 AM – 6:00 PM</b> <b>Open Daily</b>	This hilltop park is a city icon. Known for its Shiva-Parvati statue, toy train, gardens, and aerial views of the Vizag coastline.
<i>Descend to Tenneti Park (approx. 10 mins)</i>	
<b>Tenneti Park (4.4 )</b> <b>6:00 AM – 9:00 PM</b> <b>Open Daily</b>	Cliff-edge park with open lawns, benches, and direct ocean views. Peaceful and ideal for resting before wrapping up the day.
<i>Final ride to RK Beachfront (approx. 10 mins)</i>	
<b>RK Beach &amp; Museums (4.6 )</b> <b>2:00 PM – 8:30 PM</b> <b>Museums Closed: Mondays</b>	Vizag’s signature seaside zone. Visit the Submarine Museum, TU 142 Aircraft Museum, and stroll the paved beach promenade.

Day 2 : Temple Trails to Sea Views – Vizag to Lambasinghi Scenic Transfer

□ A beautiful blend of blessings and beachside serenity before heading into the misty hills of Lambasinghi.

After breakfast and checkout from your Vizag stay, your journey continues through spiritually rich sites and coastal gems before ascending into the cooler landscapes of Lambasinghi for an overnight retreat. Often referred to as the “Kashmir of Andhra,” Lambasinghi is especially popular during winter months for its fog-covered mornings and near-zero temperatures.

Destination	Highlights
<b>Simhachalam Temple (4.6□ )</b> <b>Timings:</b> 7:00 AM – 3:30 PM & 6:00 PM – 9:00 PM <b>Closed:</b> Open All Days <i>Proceed toward the coastal belt via Gajuwaka – drive offers a mix of urban and green landscapes (~45 mins).</i>	Renowned Narasimha Swamy temple perched on a hill, offering panoramic views and spiritual calm. <b>Tips:</b> Early visits avoid crowds; footwear to be left at designated counters.
<b>Yarada Beach (4.5□ )</b> <b>Timings:</b> 6:00 AM – 6:30 PM <b>Closed:</b> Open All Days	Tranquil golden sand beach cradled between hills. A great spot for photography and quiet reflection. <b>Tips:</b> No shops or facilities nearby—carry drinking water and light snacks.
<b>Dolphin Hill Viewpoint (4.3□ )</b> <b>Timings:</b> 9:00 AM – 5:00 PM <b>Closed:</b> Mondays	A restricted hilltop zone with stunning views of the Bay of Bengal and Vizag’s coastline. <b>Tips:</b> Entry may require ID verification. Limited public transport—visit via private cab.
<b>Vizag Lighthouse (4.1□ )</b> <b>Timings:</b> 10:00 AM – 5:00 PM <b>Closed:</b> Sundays <i>Begin drive to Lambasinghi (~110 km / 3.5 hrs) via Chodavaram and Narsipatnam – scenic hills, forest curves, and cooler weather await.</i>	Spiral lighthouse with panoramic views—watch the coast unfold from above. <b>Tips:</b> Entry ticket required (~₹10); avoid heels or slippery footwear.
<b>Arrival at Lambasinghi</b> <b>Evening Leisure</b> <b>Overnight Stay</b>	Reach Lambasinghi by early evening. Enjoy the misty weather, explore surroundings, and check in to your hillside stay. <b>Tips:</b> Nights can be chilly—carry light woolens even in warmer months.

**Note:** This transfer day includes ~150 km of travel over 10–12 hours including stops. From coastlines to hill drives, this route offers rich diversity—pack water, light snacks, and motion sickness tablets if needed.

Day 3 : Lambasinghi-Araku

□ Begin your day in Lambasinghi and gradually descend through scenic forests, waterfalls, and valleys en route to Araku. This tranquil leg of your journey balances nature walks, photo stops, and peaceful drives through the Eastern Ghats.

Destination	Highlights
<b>Sunrise View Point – Lambasinghi (4.4□ )</b>	Start your day early with a sunrise view over mist-covered hills. Best experienced between Nov and Feb.
<b>Strawberry Plantations (4.3□ )</b>	Walk through seasonal strawberry farms in Lambasinghi and purchase fresh local produce. Active mainly in winter.
<b>Tajangi Reservoir (4.2□ )</b>	Calm and scenic waterbody surrounded by trees and hills. Great for photos and short breaks.
<b>Kotapalli Waterfalls (4.1□ )</b>	Natural waterfall in a forested setting. Enjoy the sound of cascading water and cool surroundings.
<b>Chaparai Waterfalls (4.3□ )</b>	Flat rock stream with gently flowing water. Popular picnic and photo stop on the way to Araku.
<b>Pinery Forests (4.1□ )</b>	Peaceful pine grove perfect for short walks, fresh air, and group/family photo sessions.
<b>Arrival &amp; Check-in – Araku Valley</b>	Reach Araku by evening. Check-in to a resort or nature stay surrounded by hills and plantations.

## Day 4 : Araku sight seeing- Vizag drop

□ Your final day in Araku is a rich mix of culture, nature, and scenic travel. After breakfast and checkout, explore Araku's iconic attractions before descending back to Vizag by evening — closing your Eastern Ghats journey with unforgettable memories.

Destination	Highlights
<b>Tribal Museum (4.2□ )</b>	Explore local tribal heritage through artifacts, costumes, and interactive displays. A great cultural insight into Araku.
<b>Coffee House (4.4□ )</b>	Enjoy fresh, locally brewed Araku coffee. Ideal for a relaxing stop and souvenir shopping.
<b>Botanical Gardens (4.3□ )</b>	Beautifully maintained garden offering walking paths, shaded spots, and regional flora. Good for leisure and family time.
<b>Chocolate Factory (4.4□ )</b>	Watch how handmade chocolates are crafted using local ingredients. A quick and tasty visit.
<b>Galikonda View Point (4.4□ )</b>	One of the highest points in Araku, offering breathtaking views of the valleys and hill ranges.
<b>Coffee Plantations (4.3□ )</b>	Walk through organic coffee estates surrounded by nature. Great photo opportunities and a peaceful environment.
<b>Borra Caves (4.5□ )</b>	Majestic limestone caves with natural rock formations and lighting. A must-visit geological wonder in the region.
<b>Katiki Waterfalls (4.4□ )</b> <i>Optional / Trek Required</i>	Scenic forest waterfall accessible via short trek and jeep ride. Ideal for adventure seekers.
<b>Damuku View Point (4.1□ )</b>	Popular roadside viewpoint offering wide panoramic views — a perfect final photo stop.
<b>Return to Vizag</b>	Drop at Vizag Railway Station or Airport in the evening. Tour ends with beautiful memories.
